HOW TO GET THERE

The 68th Australian National Field Days is on Thursday 24 October to Saturday 26 October 2019.

Gates open from 8.30am and close at 5pm over the three days.

The site is located at 563 Borenore Road, 15km west of Orange. The site can be accessed by road from Orange via The Escort Way or the Cargo Road, turning right into Borenore Road just past Nashdale. From the north turn off the Mitchell Highway 5km south of Molong into Amaroo Road, which meets The Escort Way at Borenore.

Exhibitors will be marked on our site map with a yellow dot when registering at the ANFD office and will be given Parcel Pick Up docket books and instruction sheet.

The exhibitors most likely to participate are those that sell products that can be carried around the site, but where it is inconvenient for visitors to do so. This will also include small, but heavy items such as power and hand tools.

HOW THE SERVICE WORKS...

Exhibitors register to participate in the service and are given numbered, three-part docket books.

Visitors buy a product and are given the first part of the docket.

A second part of the docket is attached to the parcel.

The exhibitor then phones through to the Parcel Pick Up tent to organise for parcel collection from their site.

This alerts the providers of the Parcel Pick Up service that a parcel is ready to be collected from an exhibitor's site.

The parcel is collected by the Parcel Pick Up service provider and is taken to the car park indicated by the purchaser.

The purchaser reports to coloured carpark container and collects parcel by handing over docket that will be matched by number on article.

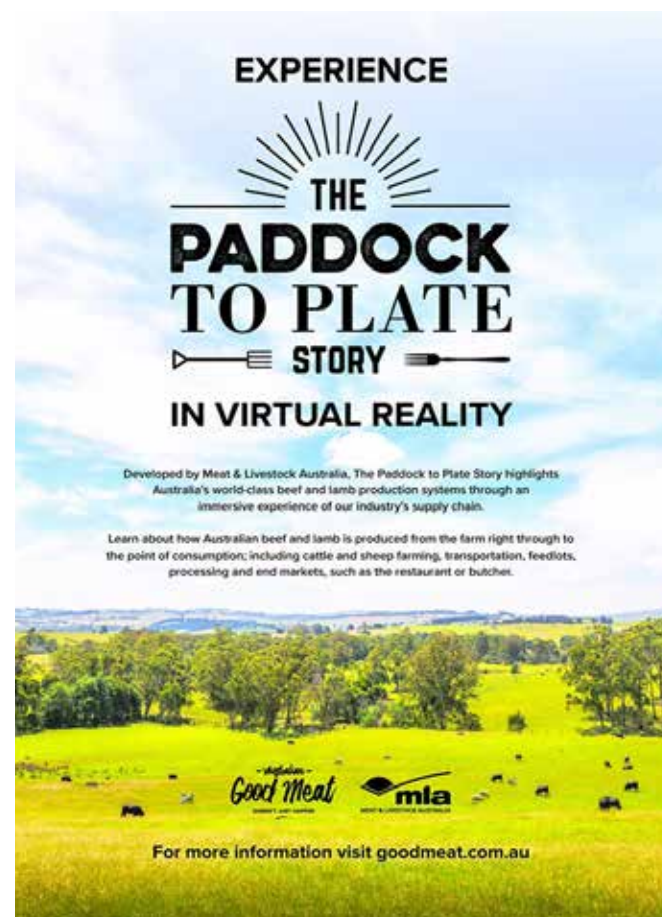

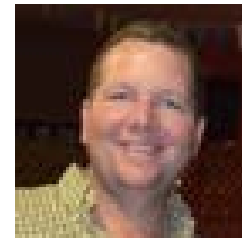

SHANNON LANDMARK
COORDINATOR, NORTHERN GENOMICS PROJECT



Shannon is a veterinarian and coordinator of the Northern Genomics Project. This project aims to develop a genetic test suitable for the northern cattle industry focusing on fertility traits: age of onset of puberty and length of lactational anoestrous.

This test can be carried out on a tail hair or DNA sample and can be conducted on cattle from birth. This gives producers an accurate prediction of what a heifer or bull's reproductive capacity is over its lifetime.

Allowing producers to make this decision from an early stage gives greater power to the decisions of whether to keep or cull heifers, whether to spey heifers or castrate bulls and increases genetic gain in a shortened period.

This test will also be invaluable in evaluating potential seedstock and bull purchases. The project has been genotyping over 30,000 females from 54 different properties that are based throughout Queensland, the Northern Territory and Western Australia.

Shannon coordinates with all the producers, veterinarians, researchers and contractors, travels out to the properties and performs ovarian scanning, pregnancy testing and herd reproductive evaluations. Shannon is also the recipient of the Zanda McDonald Award for 2019.

INNOVATIVE ANFD 1964 AWARD WINNER RETURNS – MUNRO ENGINEERS

In a world first, Munro combined a fast drilling auger with a powerful post driver in 1964 and was awarded for their innovation at the ANFD that year.

In the five decades since, the Victorian company has sold thousands of the posthole drivers in Australia and across the world.

Company owner, Warren McLean, explained the original Munro posthole driver was manufactured after a bet between two farmers about who could make the best posthole driver.

"The farmer who won the bet, Alastair Mackenzie, and his friend Max Brooke (a hydraulics engineer), approached my father Max McLean," Warren outlined.

"We finished the design and manufactured the first model in 1964. It was the first machine in the world that combined an auger and a driver for installing posts."

The popularity of the new posthole driver, which revolutionised the art of fencing, prompted Munro Engineers to specialise in fencing products.

Warren said a solid customer base was soon established with service and spare parts second to none. The increased productivity and cost savings for clients proved a winning combination.

"The feedback from customers is about how long the machine lasts, how well it's made and how well it does the job that it's designed to do," Warren outlined.

"Single man fencing contractors who have swapped to the AutoDriver say it's increased their productivity, with some doubling the number of posts they are able to install in an hour."



Today, the Ballarat Munro factory employs close to 30 people. McLean family patriarch, Max (88 years old), is still very much a part of the business.

Munro Engineers has used its innovation to become a world leader in the design and manufacture of fencing machines, from combining the first digger and driver in the world to the advanced design AutoDriver.

The suite of fencing products includes the Munro AutoDriver which combines in one machine a fast action rock breaker style hammer and a hydraulic auger for drilling pilot holes.

The Munro Multi-Sett is an all-weather system which combines a fast action earth auger for drilling a pilot hole with a powerful post driver for setting a tight post every time.

Munro Engineers design all products with the user in mind. Safety is of paramount importance. The hydraulics provide inherent fail-safe features. If a control lever is released, the action it controls stops immediately.

A series of guards prevents the operator from touching moving or dangerous parts of the machine during operation without compromising effective operation.

The recently introduced WireWinder is another great product manufactured by Munro. Allowing users to coil 500 metres of fencing in under a minute, the WireWinder is proving popular with both contractors and farmers.

For example, A 300-acre dairy farm with a lane system was wound up in just over two days with the WireWinder. This would take almost three weeks by hand.

For those involved in strip grazing, Munro have now manufactured the FenceBoss temporary electric fence system. This system is designed to make setting up and pulling down temporary electric fencing quicker, easier and safer. It prevents loss and damage to reels and pegs whilst making transporting them a breeze.

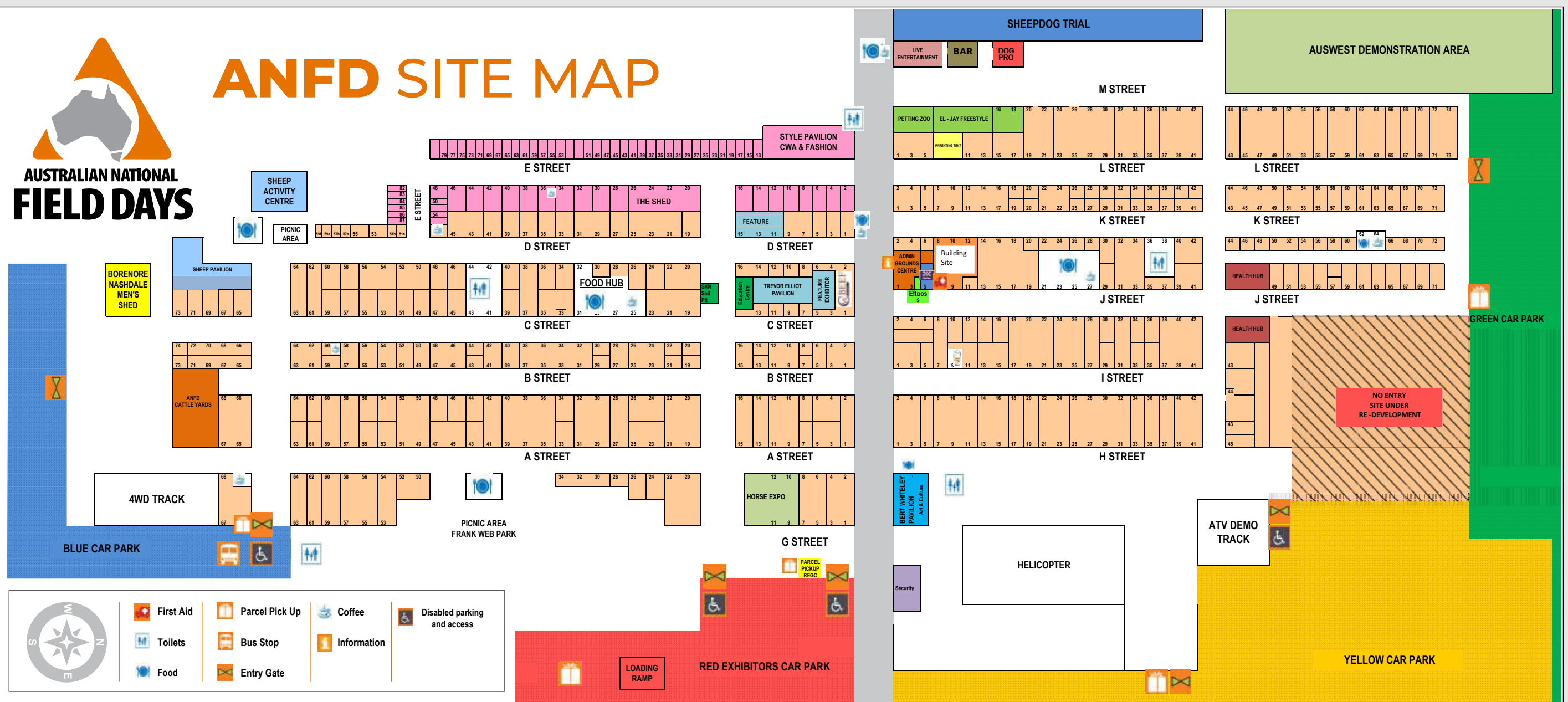
